<i>Sandoz v. State</i> , 2012 Ala. LEXIS 88 (Ala. 2012)	07/13/12	Montgomery	\$78,443,352 total; \$28,443,572 compensatory and \$50,000,000 punitive.	Reversed and rendered. Opinion by Per Curiam. Malone, Woodall, Stuart, Bolin, Murdock, Shaw and Wise concur. Parker dissents.

Opinion by Stuart. Malone, Parker, Shaw and Wise concur.

Affirmed on breach of contract claim; reversed and remanded for entry of JML on fraud and promissory fraud claims. Opinion by Main. Malone, Woodall, Stuart, Bolin and Parker concur. Shaw and Wise concur in part and dissent in part. Murdock concurs in the result in part and dissents in part.
